Lawn Care Foreman

Ideal Candidate Will:

- Have a minimum of 2 years experience with management/leadership with lawn care services
- Have a working knowledge of the use and upkeep of commercial mowers, trimmers, broadcast spreaders and other various tools used for lawn care maintenance
- Have a clean driving record and be able to obtain a medical card within 30 days
- Work in adverse weather conditions, remain standing/sitting for extended periods of time
- Review routes and apply superior time management skills to ensure crew efficiency while maintaining high quality standards and techniques is imperative
- Process daily paperwork and manage the day-to day operations of the crew
- Delegate tasks given by management and assist techs in performing task as necessary to meet deadlines
- Establish and enforce operating procedures and work standards that will ensure adequate performance and personnel safety
- Train crew members on proper safety, techniques, and procedures
- Inventory supplies of tools, equipment, or materials to ensure that sufficient supplies are available and items are in usable condition. Preparation and inspection of truck and equipment used on a daily basis. Daily and weekly maintenance of truck, trailers and all equipment associated with lawn care services.
- Master as many skills as possible through on the job training, seminars, and continuing education courses
- Acquire Wisconsin Pesticide Certification within 90 days of hire
- Perform fertilizer/weed control applications, aeration, dethatching, clean-ups as needed
- Work minimum of 10 hours a day for 5-6 days from approximately April November.
- November April is on-call for snow services
